Statement by H.E. Meles Alem, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia to the Republic of Kenya, and the Permanent Representative to UNEP, UN-HABITAT, and UNON at the Handover Ceremony of chairmanship of the Group of 77 and China at Nairobi (UNON, Nairobi, 10 March 2019)

It is my honor to address you in this important event, handing over the Chairmanship of the Group of 77 of the Nairobi Chapter for the year 2019 to the State of Palestine and to you, Excellency Hazem Shabat, Ambassador of the State of Palestine.
