It is my honour to be here today to officially hand over the Chairmanship of the Vienna Chapter of the Group of 77, to the able hands of the Distinguished Permanent Representative of Malaysia for the first half of the year 2020, and the Distinguished Permanent Representative of the Philippines for the second half of the year. Last year, as I received the Chairmanship, I asserted to all of you the importance of standing together as a Group, united by our shared goals of peace, prosperity, and sustainable development for our countries, and the world at large.

Throughout the year, we all set out together to advance the interests of the Group of 77 and China in the Vienna-based organizations. Thanks to our unity and solidarity, our collective efforts enabled us to reach significant milestones along that path.

The role and presence of the Group in Vienna is best reflected in the leadership of our most important organizations. I would also like to express our sincerest gratitude to UNIDO, for generously bearing the financial costs of the G77 Office in Vienna, something the organization has done since 1998. I take this opportunity to call upon the other Vienna-based organizations to share this burden, particularly in light of the need to reinforce the Office, and the leading role that the Group plays in Vienna.

The Vienna Chapter of the Group of 77 stands at a crucial juncture. Together, we have achieved many victories, but the road towards realizing the aspirations of our countries remains long and filled with challenges. We are now ready to hand over the torch to Malaysia, the incoming Chair of the Group for the first half of the year, and the Philippines, for the second half of the year. I am fully confident in their ability to light our path forward with conviction and leadership. Today, we stand more united than ever in our readiness to walk that path and face its challenges. Let us walk this road together.
